State-of-the-Art Marina Set to Debut Dec. 2026

The event marks the structural completion of all three buildings. The newly constructed, state-of-the-art marina, which is redefining the boating experience in northern Palm Beach County, is expected to open in Dec. 2026.

The topping-out ceremony, held at the project site at 2385 PGA Boulevard, brought together the PORT 32 team, the general contractor, Miller Construction Company, Watt, Inc., and project partners to commemorate the placement of the final structural beam in the building's framework. One beam was signed during the ceremony by project leaders and team members in recognition of the milestone. More than 150 construction workers and project team members have worked on the project to date.

PORT 32 Regional Vice President Mike Vinson and Miller Construction Company Project Manager Harley R. Miller delivered remarks during the ceremony, recognizing the project's economic impact and its role in advancing the marina's long-term redevelopment vision.

The celebration also honored the construction workforce's dedication with a catered lunch from Mission BBQ, a live DJ, a raffle, and additional activities designed to recognize the team's hard work and foster camaraderie across the project. Awards were presented to subcontractors who demonstrated exceptional performance and dedication throughout the project. Attendees were treated to intimate, guided tours led by members of the project team.

A ground-up redevelopment, PORT 32 Palm Beach Gardens will feature 471 total slips, including 451 fully enclosed dry storage slips and 20 wet slips. Designed with a clean, intuitive layout and supported by advanced marine technology, the marina places concierge-style service, hospitality, and ease at the center of the member experience.

The marina offers direct access to haul-out, launch, and provisioning services, with dry storage accommodating vessels from small tenders up to 60 feet LOA and 22 feet in height. The 20 newly constructed wet slips, designed for vessels ranging from 50 to 100 feet LOA. Transient dockage is also available.

Advanced marine infrastructure includes the largest marina forklifts in the United States, featuring 75,000-pound lifting capacity and elevating cabs that enhance precision, visibility, and safety.

PORT 32 Palm Beach Gardens is the only Category 5 hurricane-rated marina in Palm Beach County. Engineered to withstand winds up to 180 mph, the marina is recognized by most insurance providers as an accepted hurricane dockage location, offering members added peace of mind during storm season.

The property also features approximately 31,296 square feet of commercial space dedicated to marine services and boat sales, including climate-controlled marine offices and retail space, heated and cooled service units, as well as additional storage and flexible-use units.
